History of the Lenz Scholarship

The Lenz Scholarship was established and funded in 2007 by a generous donation from Herman Lenz, a 62-year Elk life member, and his wife, Muriel. Though Herman & Muriel Lenz have passed away, their daughters have fulfilled their wishes to help young people achieve an education.

Scholarship Awards

Scholarships are awarded based on the qualifications of applicants and funds available.

For the academic year 2024-2025 the following awards will be given:

1st place \$2,000.00

Qualification of Applicants

To qualify for the Lenz Scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following:

- Be a child, stepchild, grandchild, or step grandchild of a regular member of the Santa Ana Elks Lodge #794. The Sponsoring Elk must have been a regular member of the Santa Ana Elks Lodge for at least one (1) year and be a current member in good standing. Associate members do not qualify as Sponsors for the purpose of the Lenz Scholarship Application.
- 2. Believe in God.
- 3. Be an American citizen.
- 4. Be a high school senior with at least a 3.0 GPA (B average).
- 5. Demonstrate you are a well-rounded, participating student who is active in school, community, family and/or employment.
- 6. Plan to enroll in an accredited **2-year or 4-year college, university**, or acceptable **vocational school** (at the discretion of Santa Ana Elks Scholarship Committee).
- 7. Complete the Lenz Scholarship **application form** in its entirety.
- 8. Provide a **copy of your transcript** (unofficial transcripts are acceptable).
- 9. Provide **3 letters of reference** from <u>each</u> of the following: (1) a teacher, (2) a counselor, (3) a community member. These may be attached to the student's application packet or sent directly by the teacher, counselor, or community member.

Scoring of Applications

The Santa Ana Lodge Scholarship Committee will assess applications and select the winners. Winners will receive a "Verification of Enrollment" form to be completed after enrolling at the school you will be attending. When the Lodge receives that form and the required documentation of enrollment, a check will be sent as described on the verification form. If you elect to delay using the scholarship in the academic year for which it was awarded, a written request must be made to the Scholarship Committee. The scholarship must be used within 18 months of its receipt.

Applications must be received at the Santa Ana Elks Lodge no later than 5:00 pm January 24, 2025
